

CREDIT TRANSFER

Upon request, Makana Academy will review prior credit for coursework earned from other institutions. Requests for a review of prior credit shall be made in writing to the Director of Education prior to enrolling. Makana Academy does not guarantee that prior credit will be granted though, and final the determination will be made by the Director of Education on a case by case basis. Copies of all records and requests for prior credit review will be kept in the students file.

Students receiving VA educational benefits do not have the option of having prior credit reviewed. All previous education and training must be provided to the school for review. Both the law and regulations require schools to grant appropriate credit for prior training and experience. The current procedure provides for termination of VA benefits if the school does not furnish an evaluation of prior credit within one (1) term (38 U.S.C. 3675(b)(2) and 3676(c)(4), and §21.4253(d)(3) and 4254(c)(4)). Prior credit is defined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as "the amount of credit allowed for previous education, training, and experience, including military training and experience".

The transferability of clock hours and certificate earned at Makana Academy to another institution is at the complete discretion of the institution to which you seek to transfer. If the clock hours or certificate that you earn at this institution is not accepted at the institution to which you seek to transfer, you may be required to repeat some or all of your coursework at that institution. For this reason, you should make certain that your attendance at this institution will meet your educational goals. This may include contacting an institution to which you may seek to transfer after attending Makana Academy to determine if your credits or diploma will transfer.
